Eurana Park Concession Stand Will Open On June 2nd for Take-Out Only

The Eurana Park Concession Stand will open on June 2nd for take-out only using social distancing guidelines. Menu options and hours may initially be limited and will depend on stand activity.

Regarding outdoor eating areas under Covid 19 pandemic:

Per the PA Dept. of Agriculture, outdoor seating & eating areas; including picnic table set ups are NOT ALLOWED under RED or YELLOW phases. That is considered dine-in service & can lead to crowds gathering in a less than 6-foot distance. Retail food facilities may continue to operate on a limited basis for curbside pickup, takeout or delivery only during the YELLOW & GREEN phase. Facilities providing take out or curbside pick-up should encourage customers to take their food home or eat in their cars where social distancing can be maintained.

Weatherly Borough office has received numerous calls and questions recently regarding keeping and housing chickens within the borough. **Please be advised that chicken coops to be placed on a property require a zoning permit.** In addition, per the Animal Ordinance, if more than four (4) animals, six (6) months of age or over are kept on any premises, regardless of the number of owners, the owner of the premises must notify and register with the Weatherly Borough Health Department. Failure to so notify and register constitutes a violation of this ordinance. Please note that if there is a complaint regarding odor or noise as a result of keeping chickens, the owner will be asked to remove them. In addition, keeping roosters is against Borough policy.

Weatherly Borough residents have been experiencing instances recently regarding bears or other animals getting into garbage and /or taking it off the property. Please be advised that per:



**Borough Ordinance CHAPTER 38:
GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND REFUSE**

Sect. 38.3. Administration of refuse collection.

D. Ownership of refuse material set out for collection shall remain vested in the owner until collected.

Therefore, any garbage bags or garbage material of an individual property owner that a bear or other animal may take to another property is **STILL the property of the original owner until the refuse company collects it. The original owner is responsible for clean-up.** If materials belonging to one owner are found on another property, the owner of those materials will be asked to remove them.

Weatherly Borough real estate and per capita tax bills have been mailed directly by the printer to taxpayers. One check or money order can be used for the payment of all Weatherly Borough taxes. Per capita tax is due from every resident 18 years of age or older. This tax is not paid from the escrow account of mortgages. Carbon County tax bills have been mailed in a separate envelope. A separate check or money order is needed for the payment of Carbon County taxes. Please contact tax collector Deborah A. Kohler at 570-427-4765 IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED your tax bill or have any questions.

Due to social distancing required to prevent the spread of the coronavirus, there will be NO in person office hours as listed on the tax bills at this time. Office hours will resume when municipal offices reopen to the public. Payments can be left in the locked mailbox or mailed to 794 North Street, Weatherly, PA 18255. Please include all copies of the tax bills and a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like "PAID" receipts returned to you.
