



POOL RULES

1. All uses of Eurana Park lake above the age of 5 must display the proper swimming tag.
2. Swimming in long pants is prohibited.
3. Non-swimmers must keep within the confines of the lifeline.
4. Floatation devices are permitted only with lifeguard approval.
5. Diving from the wall into the non-swimmers is prohibited.
6. Shoving persons from the diving boards, wall or raft is prohibited.
7. No running shall be permitted in the pool area.
8. Standing or kneeling while going down the pool slide is dangerous and prohibited. Likewise is diving from the slide ladder, and climbing the supporting structure.
9. All swimmers under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult.
10. Swimming is not permitted under the raft, nor in the channel behind the island.
11. Glass containers will not be permitted in the pool area.
12. No profane language is allowed.
13. Throwing of any object into the pool is prohibited.
14. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult while walking or playing within 20' of the pool during non-swimming hours.
15. The lifeguard is in charge of the pool when on duty. He/She has discretionary authority for the sake of the safety and enjoyment of the pool. Users who refuse to take orders from the Lifeguard will be asked to leave the pool.

Swimming is permitted ONLY when a lifeguard is on duty.

Games of Tag and Catch cannot be allowed to endanger the welfare or enjoyment of other pool users.



PARK RULES

1. The Park is under the supervision of the Park Manager, who is authorized to forbid the misuse of the facilities by anyone acting in a manner that threatens the mutual enjoyment of the Park. The Park Manager may be contacted through the refreshment stand.
2. This Park is for your use and pleasure. Please help to keep it clean and respectable.
3. Littering park ground with paper, trash or rubbish of any kind is prohibited. Trash cans are plentiful. Please use them.
4. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs of any kind are prohibited on park grounds.
5. PETS ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN AREAS CLEARLY MARKED BY SIGNAGE AS POSTED BY THE BOROUGH.
6. **Motor vehicles are prohibited on the Park ground. Exceptions to this rule are by authority of the Park Manager. However, you may drive your vehicle to the shelter for unloading and loading purposes only. Your vehicle must be moved to the parking areas immediately after unloading or loading.**
7. Bicycles and other non-motorized vehicles are not permitted in the park.
8. Charcoal burners and grills are permitted in the picnic areas. Please do not throw the charcoal in trash cans.
9. Sitting on the backs of the park benches is prohibited.
10. Removing or moving of any bench, table or other park property is prohibited without permission.
11. The carrying or discharge of any firearm, slingshot, and firecrackers, other missile propelling instruments or explosives are prohibited in the park.
12. The use of profane or obscene language or gestures is prohibited.
13. Disorderly or immoral acts are prohibited.
14. Anyone caught in the act of destroying or damaging park property will be subject to a fine and liable for the damages. In addition, they can be ejected from all park grounds.

**PARK SHELTER & BANDSHELL
INFORMATION**

There are 2 outdoor, covered park shelters and 1 covered bandshell on the Eurana Park grounds.

These are available for the general public to use. At all times, park rules apply to these areas as well as to all park grounds.

Individual Shelters and/or the Bandshell may be reserved by individuals or groups for specific events, times or days. Reservations **MUST BE MADE** by contacting the Weatherly Borough Office at 570-427-8640. Fees may apply. Contact the office for availability and applicable fees.

If a shelter and/or the bandshell is **NOT** reserved, the public may use them free of charge. If a shelter and/or the bandshell **IS** reserved, anyone in the public who might be using those areas unaware of the reservation, must vacate the area in respect for the reserved party.

Please do not arrive earlier than 9:00 a.m. at your RESERVED shelter to set up for your event. This will give the park staff time to prepare & clean up the shelter in advance of your arrival.

Shelter #1

- **18 picnic tables that each seat 8 for a total of 144 seats.**

Shelter #2

- **18 picnic tables that each seat 8 for a total of 144 seats.**

Bandshell

- **Equipped with electricity. See the Park Manager for details.**

Handicap seating is located on the outside facing picnic tables that have an overhanging extension suitable for wheelchairs.

Each shelter has a charcoal grill available for use located at the lower end of each shelter, as well as electric outlets and automatic lighting for evening. Renters are cautioned not to overload the electric outlets. If using coffee pots, brew coffee before any other heat producing items are used.
