The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has mandated all community and non-transient non-community water systems to submit a service line inventory to identify the material of all service lines connected to the public water distribution system by **Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024**.

The Weatherly Borough is requesting your help in identifying and ultimately removing lead service lines from existing infrastructures.

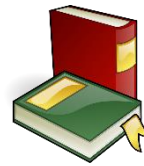
