

ORDINANCE 91-15 SNOW BAN PARKING & SNOW REMOVAL

Updated November 2024

A. The following regulations **shall be enforced**, whenever an appreciable amount of snow falls or is predicted by radio, press or television, or whenever an emergency is declared through such media, on those streets and highways hereinafter designated:

1. First Street; no parking on south side
2. Second Street; no parking on south side
3. East Second Street; no parking
4. Third Street; no parking on south side
5. Fourth Street; no parking on south side
6. Fifth Street; no parking on either side from Carbon Street to the west terminus
7. Sixth Street; no parking
8. Seventh Street; no parking on south side and no parking on north and south side from Pardee Street to terminus
9. Eighth Street; no parking
10. Packer Street; no parking on west side and no parking on either side 60' south of terminus
11. Eurana Avenue; no parking
12. Wilbur Street; no parking
13. Fairview Street; no parking
14. Hudsondale Street; no parking
15. Butz Street; no parking
16. Franklin Street; no parking on east side
17. Jefferson Street; no parking on either side
18. West Main Street; no parking
19. Lauderburn Avenue; no parking; snow is plowed to both sides
20. Plane Street; no parking on north side
21. Spring Street; no parking on either side of the street from Church Street north to terminus
22. Spring Street; no parking on east side from East Main Street to Church Street
23. Pardee Street; no parking on west side
24. Fell Street; no parking on west side
25. Blakeslee Street; no parking on east side
26. Dunnigan Street; no parking on east side
27. Kline Street; no parking on west side
28. North Street; no parking from Hill Street to terminus east and no parking on south side between Hill Street and Eurana Avenue and no parking from Eurana Avenue to Union Cemetery going east
29. Norman Street; no parking
30. Carbon Street: from East Main Street to 140 Carbon Street and no parking from Second Street to Fifth Street On either side during REVERSE SNOW BAN
31. Smith Street; no parking
32. High Street; no parking on either side
33. Allen Avenue; no parking
34. Steel Plant Road; no parking
35. Dunnigan Lane; no parking
36. Edee Avenue; no parking
37. East Main Street; no parking
38. Buttonwood Street; no parking
39. Yeakle Street; no parking on either side

B. Within (12) hours after the end of the storm, on all streets designated above, with parking restrictions on one side cars shall be moved to the opposite side with the exception of the following streets: Yeakle Street and Carbon Street (Second to Fifth Streets). Cars must be removed from the street.

THE REVERSE SNOW BAN AND WHAT TIME IT WILL GO INTO EFFECT WILL BE ANNOUNCED VIA THE BOROUGH’S CODE RED TELEPHONE SYSTEM, THE MEDIA AND BOTH THE WEATHERLY POLICE DEPARTMENT FACEBOOK PAGE AND THE WEATHERLY BOROUGH FACEBOOK PAGE. NO CARS SHOULD BE MOVED UNTIL THE DESIGNATED TIMES ARE ANNOUNCED.

Removal of Vehicles: Any vehicle that impedes the plowing of the streets by violation of Section 91-17(A) of this ordinance and/or (B) of this ordinance may be removed and/or at the owner’s expense. The Borough shall have the authority to remove or to order the removal (and by impounding if deemed necessary) of any vehicles which impede the plowing of streets by violating the above-referenced section. The owner of the vehicle shall be responsible for the payment of towing and/or storage charges. The payment of towing and storage charges shall not relieve the owner or driver of any vehicle from liability for any fine or penalty for the violation of the provision of this ordinance for which the vehicle was removed or impounded.

Parking Lots During Snow Ban: The parking lot on the south side of the borough building will be cleared of all vehicles.

Parking Lots During Reverse Snow Ban are TO BE CLEARED OF ALL VEHICLES WITHIN (9-12) HOURS AFTER THE END OF THE STORM:

- A. Parking lot on the north side of the borough building
- B. Parking lot on the east side of Carbon Street between Second and Smith Street

Violations and penalties: Any person violating the provisions of this Article shall be guilty of a violation of this Article, for which violation the said person shall be liable to pay a fine of \$75.00 for each offense, plus costs, and each daily occurrence of the same offense shall be considered as a new offense and shall be fined as such payable to the Borough of Weatherly. If this fine is not paid within (5) five days from the date of issuance of the ticket, a citation shall be issued and upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75.00 plus court costs.

Portable Basketball Courts

Residents with portable basketball courts are asked to make sure they are at least 10 feet away from any street or alley edge during the winter season, so as not to interfere with snow plowing efforts

Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal

All owners or agents of vacant houses or lots AND occupiers of houses or lots are required to remove all snow & ice on sidewalks within 12 hours after each snowstorm ends. Non-removal is considered a nuisance and subject to a fine not to exceed \$300
