TO ALL RESIDENTS

Reminder to Residents from Weatherly Borough Tax Collector

PENALTY VALUE is now due for the real estate and per capita taxes for all municipalities

Late notices have been mailed for unpaid real estate taxes.

Per capita penalty values are \$5.50 for borough and \$11.00 for school if paid to the tax collector by December 31st, 2024. Fees charged by the delinguent tax collectors (Berkheimer for borough and JP Harris Associates for school) will significantly increase the amount due for each per capita bill. Personal or business checks will not be accepted after December 15th, 2024.

Separate money orders, cashier's checks or certified checks pavable to Deborah A. Kohler for the tax of each municipality are required. **Payments must** be postmarked by December 31st,2024.

TO PAY WITH A CREDIT CARD, please call with your information. A convenience fee of 2.65% of the total amount due or minimum fee of \$3.00 (whichever is greater) will be charged by the processor. Last day to pay with credit cards will be December 26th, 2024.

Please drop off or mail payments to: 794 North Street, Weatherly, PA 18255. Enclose all copies of the bills and a self-addressed, stamped envelope if "PAID" receipts are desired.

IF A HOMESTEAD EXCLUSION APPLICATION FORM IS RECEIVED, COMPLETE AND RETURN IT TO THE TAX ASSESSMENT OFFICE BY THE MARCH 1ST, 2025 deadline. Failure to complete and submit the form will remove the homestead exclusion even though you may have been approved in a previous year.

Information in the Carbon County Assessment database is constantly being updated and specific changes made on your property record card signal the computer system to send a new homestead exclusion application form to the taxpayer for update.
