REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS:

METER READING NOTICE

Borough residents are asked to ensure that your sidewalk(s) and/or paths have been shoveled and cleared so that our borough employees have safe access to your meters for meter readings. Please keep the paths clear from snow, ice, brush & debris.

SIDEWALK SNOW & ICE REMOVAL Ordinance # 79-16

All owners or agents of vacant houses or lots AND occupiers of houses or lots are required to remove all snow & ice on sidewalks within (12) hours after each snowstorm ends. Non-removal is considered a nuisance & subject to a fine not to exceed **\$300.00**.

ALL GARBAGE MUST BE:

Put out on Sunday evening. Haulers may pick up as early as 3:00 am on the day of pick-up.

To avoid water collection, containers should have the lids on. 6 bag limit per week & **1 bulk item per month is accepted.**

HELP US GET THE LEAD OUT!

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has mandated all community and non-transient non-community water systems to submit a service line inventory annually to identify the material of all service lines connected to the public water distribution system. **If you have filled out your survey, no further action is required.** If you have not, please take a few minutes to help us update the service line material on the customer side. Handicap Parking Permit Renewal

All Weatherly residents with a current permit must be renewed annually!

The renewal applications will be mailed out in January 2026. Completed renewal applications should be mailed to the Borough Office & accompanied by the renewal fee of \$5.00 payable to Weatherly Borough for a non-personalized parking space each year.



NEW applicants requesting a handicap parking space should complete an application to the Borough Office for review. A fee of \$5.00 is payable at the time of application with a copy of Placard or Vehicle Registration. Payments can be accepted in the form of Checks, Money Orders, & Credit/Debit Cards (In person only)

Weatherly Borough Tax Collector 2026 INFORMATION

Information in the Carbon County Assessment database is constantly being updated and specific changes made on your property record card signal the computer system to send a new homestead exclusion application form to the taxpayer for update.

IF A HOMESTEAD EXCLUSION APPLICATION FORM IS RECEIVED, COMPLETE AND RETURN IT TO THE TAX ASSESSMENT OFFICE BY THE MARCH 1ST, 2026 deadline.

Failure to complete and submit the form will remove the homestead exclusion even though you may have been approved in a previous year.
