### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER FAILURE TO SUBMIT REQUIRED CORROSION CONTROL TREATMENT/PERMIT ON TIME

#### Weatherly Borough Has Violated a Treatment Technique

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We failed to meet the permit application deadline of March 31, 2025 for the corrosion control treatment.

#### What should I do?

- **You do not need to use an alternative (i.e., bottled water) water supply.** However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

#### What does this mean?

- This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately.

#### What happened? What was done?

We are working with DEP to install corrosion control treatment. The engineers are working on the final aspects of filing the permit for the corrosion control treatment.

We anticipate resolving the problem within 30-45 days.
